There are some phenomena, however, that strongly suggest (to me) that language generation will turn out to involve Pandemonium – opportunistic, parallel, evolutionary processes – almost all the way down. (241-242)

and it is on those days I realize that precisely because there is so much chaos I like the office: lots of duplicated efforts periods of layabout and interference by machines that don't work as well as mine does The whole office reminds me of pandemonium, a place where fallen angels argue their way to war, or congressional reps impair the latest attempts of citizens to serve the state... So let chaos reign for at least eight hours of every day confounding the supposed order so that the way we process thoughts separately also becomes the diversity by the way we process them together.
